TRASH COLLECTION

The contract with Clinton County Disposal has been renewed and trash pickup will continue to be on **Thursdays**. All garbage needs to be at the **curbside no later than 7:00am**. Effective January 1, 2016 garbage collection fees will increase by \$1.00 due to the new contract. Senior rates will be \$10.00/month and will be allowed five (5) 33 gallon trash bags or 2-33 gallon trash cans per week (If you are 62 or older, please contact the utilities office to receive the senior rate). Regular rates will be \$10.50/month and customers are allowed eight (8) 33-gallon bags or 4-33 gallon trash cans per week. Large item pickup can be arranged by calling **Clinton County Disposal at 800-892-4804**. Clinton County Disposal requires payment at the time of service for special pickup items.
