Wastewater Grant Application

The Kirklín wastewater treatment plant must be updated! The Kirklín Town Council has approved applying for the maximum IOGRA grant possible which is \$650,000.00. The total cost of the project is \$1,488,800.00. Receiving this grant will have a significant impact on the rates charged for wastewater. One very important aspect of

the application review process is community support. We need letters of support from the community. The scoring committee will consider those applications first who have strong community support. The scoring committee wants to see letters from Kirklín residents stating the impact that
