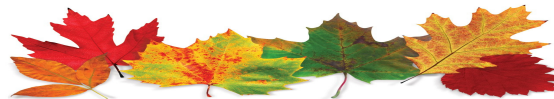
WE GOT IT!

'Tis That Time of Year Again

.....where the leaves will soon begin falling (whether we are ready for it or not!). This is just a friendly reminder that town employees do pick up leaves on Mondays in the fall *but they must be bagged*. In addition, limbs and brush must be in small enough bundles that one person can handle alone. For branches, make sure they are no wider than 4" in diameter and that all cut ends are facing the same direction Also, they **MUST** be at the curb **NO LATER** than 8am or you may have to wait until the following week.



Please **do not** blow leaves from your yard into the street as this is a large contributor to storm drains getting clogged!!
