RESOLUTION 2025-5-1 - Melinda Jobe read Resolution #2025-5-1 "Authorizing Comcast full authorization to perform the work are previously granted under the approved permits to construct in the rights-of-way of Town of Kirklin which shall include the replacement of the current approx. 3' in height pedestals where feasible with approx. 1' in height pedestals and completing the remaining portion of their work, and any future pedestals, at the same 1' height." Tara Walker asked Jay Moore what would happen if the town asked Comcast to stop work. Jay Moore replied that the Town would be in breach of contract. Brent Stetler made a motion to approve Resolution #2025-5-1. The motion was supported by Walt Minnick and it carried with a unanimous vote.

INVOICE #109 – Brent Stetler made a motion to approve the payment of Invoice #109 to Craig Hudzinski in the amount of \$1,155.00 for labor and material to fix leaks at the park bathrooms. The motion was supported by Walt Minnick and passed with the following votes: Brent Stetler, yes; Walt Minnick, yes; Melinda Jobe, yes; and Craig Hudzinski, abstained.
