WHEREAS, the purpose of Ordinance Section 90.29 is to protect the citizens of Kirklin, Indiana from dangerous, vicious, and voracious animals;

WHEREAS, the Town of Kirklin has determined that including certain breeds of dogs in the prohibited animals within the Town of Kirklin is an inefficient means to exclude dangerous, vicious, and voracious animals and the cost of proving the animals breed by DNA testing or other scientific methods is an unnecessary expense.
