



ORDINANCE NO. 2024-8-2

OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLIN, INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY AND STREET

The Town of Kirklin, Indiana, having considered the Petition to Vacate Alley and Street filed by Drew Miller and Rebecca Miller, as husband and wife; Christian A. Curry and Stephanie A. Curry, as husband and wife, and notice having been given and a public hearing held, all in accordance with the provisions of I.C. §5-3-1 and I.C. §36-7-3-12, it is

ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirklin, Indiana, that the following described alley and street located in Kirklin Township, Clinton County, Indiana, to-wit:

That part of the east-west alley that lies between and abuts Lots Numbered Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) and the north-south street that lies east of Lots Numbered Three (3) and Eight (8) and west of Lots Numbered Four (4) and Seven (7) in Myers' 1st Addition of the Original Plat of the Town of Kirklin, as the same is recorded in Plat Book 2 (new), Page 221.

be and the same hereby is VACATED; that title to the east-west alley between Lots Numbered Three (3) and Eight (8) and the west half of the north-south street be vested in Drew Miller and Rebecca Miller, as husband and wife; and title to the east-west alley between Lots Numbered Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7) and the east half of the north-south street be vested in Christian A. Curry and Stephanie A. Curry, as husband and wife;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that after inspection by Town officials of the alley and street and the records of the Town of Kirklin that no Town utilities are located in the alley and street and therefore releases and disclaims any easement rights for utilities in the alley and street herein described.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirklin, Indiana, that petitioners shall furnish a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Clinton County for the transfer and to the Recorder of Clinton County for recording at the petitioners' expense;






