AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY

The Town of Kirklin, Indiana, having considered the Petition to Vacate Alley filed by Melvin Lytton and Joanne Lytton, and notice having been given and a public hearing held, all in accordance with the provisions of I.C. §5-3-1 and I.C. §36-7-3-12, it is

ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirklin, Indiana, that the following described alley located in Kirklin Township, Clinton County, Indiana, to-wit:

That the part of the east-west alley that lies between and abuts Lots Numbered One (1), Two (2), Nine (9) and Ten (10) in Myers' 1st Addition of the Original Plat of the Town of Kirklin, as the same is recorded in Plat Book 2 (new), Page 221.

be and the same hereby is VACATED; that title to the entirety of the above-described east-west alley, VEST in Melvin Lytton and Joanne Lytton, husband and wife;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that after inspection by Town officials of the alley and the records of the Town of Kirklin that no Town utilities are located in the alley and therefore releases and disclaims any easement rights for utilities in the alley herein described.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirklin, Indiana, that petitioners shall furnish a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Clinton County for the transfer and to the Recorder of Clinton County for recording at the petitioners' expense;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirklin, Indiana, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage this ________ day of __________, 2024.
